Colonial Sportsmen's Club Application Process

The Colonial Sportsmen's Club is a social club *with a pool*. It is a non-profit organization. Your initiation fee and annual dues go towards the maintenance of the property and the betterment of the Club. The one-time \$200.00 initiation fee has been waived.

New Members must meet with a Club Officer to review the New Member Information (or attend a Club Meeting: first Thursday of month – beginning in March, 7:30pm at Clubhouse). With submission of an Application and check for Dues, you will be a Proposed new member and can begin to use the Club. Officially, you will be proposed at the next meeting and voted in the following month. Once you are voted in you will become an Associate Member of the CSC.

SUMMARY OF CSC REGULATIONS

- 1. When entering the club grounds for any reason, you must sign in under the pavilion (during Swim Season) or, in the Pavilion kitchen.
- 2. Sign in guests and pay guest fees. Guest fees are posted at sign-in table.
- 3. Children of Members 17 and under must be accompanied by a parent, or other adult member who takes responsibility for them.
- 4. Do not eat or drink in or around the pool.
- 5. No glassware allowed in or around pool.
- 6. No diving or jumping off the sides of the diving board. Dive and jump forward off the front end of the diving board.
- 7. No ball playing in or around the pool, except by permission of lifeguards.
- 8. Do not block pool ladders.
- All persons are forbidden to use pool except when lifeguards are on duty. Normal duty hours are 11:30am to 8:30pm.
- 10. No one under influence of alcohol will be allowed in pool area.
- 11. Lifeguards have authority to dismiss any persons from pool or pool area for safety or health reasons or pool regulation violations.
- 12. Non-swimmers not allowed in deep end of pool (beyond the flotation rope).
- 13. For safety and health reasons, infants, babes-in-arms, babes in diapers, and non-toilet-trained children are not allowed in the main pool.
- 14. Non-swimmers (children) using wading section of pool shall be accompanied by a parent or designated adult in the pool or observing from the apron.
- 15. Except for body attached types (arms, waist, and chest) separate flotation devices such as tubes, air-inflated animals, Styrofoam boards, etc., are not allowed in the pool at any time
